## FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE Revised

House Bill 137 Economic Matters (Charles County Delegation)

Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

#### **Charles County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Fees**

This bill increases the annual license fees for various alcoholic beverages licenses in Charles County. The bill also establishes additional annual fees that apply when a license holder provides live entertainment or outdoor seating under Class C, D, and H on-sale licenses.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2015.

### **Fiscal Summary**

#### State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Charles County revenues increase by approximately \$33,400 annually beginning in FY 2016 due to the annual fee increases and additional fees assessed. Expenditures are not directly affected.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal overall, but potential meaningful for small businesses that are required to pay additional fees.

### Analysis

#### **Bill Summary/Current Law:**

#### Annual License Fees

The bill increases license fees for the sale of alcoholic beverages in Charles County as shown in **Exhibit 1**.

## Annual Fees for Providing Live Entertainment or Outdoor Table Service

The bill also establishes additional annual fees that apply when license holders provide live entertainment or outdoor table service in Charles County under Class C, D, and H on-sale licenses. Both fees are \$200; thus, a licensee that provides both live entertainment and outdoor table service pays \$400. These are the same fees that exist in statute for establishments that provide live entertainment or outdoor table service under various Class B licenses. Although the existing \$200 fees for live entertainment and outdoor table service for Class B licenses took effect July 1, 2014, the county advises that those fees have not yet been charged. The county intends to begin assessing these fees as of July 1, 2015.

**Background:** Charles County advises that, in fiscal 2014, there were 26 Class A beer, wine, and liquor licenses; 12 Class C beer, wine, and liquor licenses; 1 Class D beer license; 2 Class D beer and wine licenses; a total of 66 Class D beer, wine, and liquor licenses; and 9 Class H licenses in effect.

**Local Revenues:** Based on data provided by Charles County, county revenues increase by approximately \$27,800 due to the increases in the annual license fees and by approximately \$5,600 due to the assessment of additional annual fees that apply to licensees that provide live entertainment and/or outdoor table service.
