10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

The purpose of the non-profit Bruin Athletic Boosters Club, Inc. is to raise funds to supplement Broadneck High School's Athletic Department budget and to enhance the character of the sporting activities of the school through various means of support. Through targeted fundraising, the Bruin Athletic Boosters Club has completed many projects:

- * Completed major renovation of Stadium Press Box
- * Completed commercial kitchen upgrades to Concessions Stand
- * Installed state-of-the-art scoreboards in the gymnasium
- * Installed baseball and softball complex scoreboards
- * Installed multiple grass field irrigation systems
- * Replaced deteriorating Field House roofing and gymnasium lighting

adding value to the high school athletic complex at Broadneck High School.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Originally constructed in 1990-91, the Broadneck High School Field House was built to serve a student population of 1000. Current enrollment has swelled to 2200 students. Updates and renovation of the Field House will include the following capital improvements:

- * Stormwater remediation and regrading to resolve drainage problems at the North end of building, affecting the field house, outdoor track and tennis courts
- * Upgraded plumbing, electrical & HVAC
- * Restrooms to commercial grade
- * Team meeting/film rooms
- * Coaches offices
- * Office space/training room for athletic trainers & injured athletes
- * New lockers for female and male athletes

Please note: The property (Broadneck High School and the Field House) is owned by the Anne Arundel County Board of Education, and it is our goal to assist in making improvements to the building and grounds, in a similar fashion to the Concessions Stand building improvements, undertaken and funded by the Bruin Athletic Boosters Club, Inc. in the Fall of 2014. The field house renovation project will follow the guidelines of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education third party project process. The Bruin Athletic Boosters Club, Inc. and the Broadneck High School Administration have worked under these guidelines on previous occasions.

The Field House is used by nine athletic teams and 350 BHS student athletes per school year. Visiting athletic teams from all twelve county high schools also use the facility. The public restrooms are used by school and community groups, club sports and recreational leagues, at Music Boosters high school band competitions and at recreational sporting events, including multi-team tournaments.

The stormwater remediation and drainage work associated with this project is critical. Even the slightest rainfall floods the Field House facility and surrounding stadium areas. This is not only a nuisance, but a health and safety hazard that must be corrected.

Renovating and upgrading the facility will enhance the property, the grounds and the enjoyment of the entire community.
