The funds will be used to purchase new scoreboards for the softball field and the baseball stadium. The current scoreboards are inadequate to handle the current level of use, have constant and costly electrical and mechanical problems, it is difficult to obtain parts for the old scoreboards and the technology is over thirty years old. The proposed scoreboards will include energy saving, wide angle amber LED lights and wireless controllers. The scoreboards will be installed on property in the Montgomery Blair Regional Park, which is owned and operated by the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission. The fields are used by athletic groups from throughout Montgomery County and by the Montgomery Blair High School sport teams. Montgomery Blair Regional Park is adjacent to Montgomery Blair High School.
