## 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Jewish Foundation for Group Homes is a non-profit organization dedicated to enhancing the independence, dignity, choice, and community inclusion of individuals with disabilities, regardless of faith or creed. JFGH's programs support more than 200 individuals in over 70 sites throughout the Washington D.C. Metropolitan area. Support is provided through JFGH's residential, transitioning youth and social programs.

JFGH provides training to enhance independent living skills, personal assistance with daily living, and long-term support. All JFGH residents are employed, enrolled in school, or participate in day programs. To the extent of their abilities, the residents also share in the household chores such as doing laundry and assisting with meal preparation. JFGH provides safe, comfortable, and attractive homes, staffed with trained direct-care providers and offers a range of activities for its residents.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

JFGH supports individuals with disabilities in 20 homes in Montgomery County. The average age of our homes is 49 years. Repairs and renovations are necessary to maintain safety, particularly for our residents with accessibility issues.

In FY2016, renovations are planned for 7 group homes (3 of which are accessible):

- \* Modify bathrooms (roll-in showers and drains, lowered sinks, non-slip flooring and grab bars) to ensure safety for non-ambulatory residents.
- \* Reinforcing bowed floor foundations compromised by heavy multiple wheelchair use.
- \* Renovate other bathrooms, replacing sub-floors and waterproofing.
- \* Redesign kitchens to provide more accessibility and increase functionality.
- \* Replace HVAC units at three homes.
- \* Construct ramp from driveway to front door at one home.
