Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Hours of Sale on Sundays for Holders of Class A Licenses

This bill alters the hours of sale, on Sundays, for holders of Class A off-sale licenses in Carroll County. Specifically, the bill authorizes license holders to sell alcoholic beverages between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m., instead of 11 a.m. and 11 p.m. The bill also clarifies that the provision of law modified by the bill refers to Class A off-sale licenses.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2015.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Enforcement can likely be handled with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: Minimal overall, but potential meaningful positive impact for any qualifying licensee permitted to open earlier on Sundays.

Analysis

Current Law: Holders of Class A off-sale licenses may sell alcoholic beverages between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and between 11 a.m. and 11 p.m. on Sunday.

Background: In fiscal 2014, there were 41 Class A off-sale licenses issued in Carroll County. One was a Class A off-sale beer and wine license, and 40 were Class A off-sale beer, wine, and liquor licenses.
