# <u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 340</u> (Third Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after "vote;" insert "<u>making a conforming change</u>;"; and in line 15, after "3-102" insert "<u>and 16-202</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 26, insert:

"<u>16–202.</u>

(a) <u>A person who has been convicted of a felony and is [actually]</u> CURRENTLY serving a court-ordered sentence of imprisonment[, including any term of parole or probation,] for the conviction, and has been rendered ineligible to vote pursuant to § 3-102(b) of this article, may not vote or attempt to vote during the time that the person is rendered ineligible to vote.

(b) <u>A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and is subject to</u> <u>imprisonment for not less than 1 year nor more than 5 years.</u>".
