AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 466 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "State Highway Administration" and substitute "<u>Transportation</u>"; in the same line, strike "- Gold Star Families"; in line 4, strike "State Highway Administration" and substitute "<u>Department of Transportation</u>"; in line 5, strike "a member of the General Assembly" and substitute "<u>certain persons</u>"; strike beginning with ", on" in line 5 down through "recipient," in line 6; strike beginning with "the" in line 7 down through "combat" in line 8 and substitute "<u>a certain member of the armed forces or a certain emergency responder</u>"; and in line 8, strike "State highways" and substitute "<u>the dedication of State highways</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 1, strike "ADMINISTRATION" and substitute "<u>DEPARTMENT</u>"; in line 2, after "ASSEMBLY" insert "<u>, ANOTHER ELECTED OFFICIAL, OR ANY</u> <u>MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC</u>"; strike beginning with ", ON" in line 2 down through "COMBAT" in line 8 and substitute "<u>THAT THE DEPARTMENT DEDICATE A</u> <u>BRIDGE OR ANOTHER APPROPRIATE TRANSPORTATION STRUCTURE UNDER THE</u> JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT TO:

(1) <u>A DECEASED MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES WHOSE</u> SURVIVING SPOUSE, PARENT, OR NEXT OF KIN IS A RECIPIENT OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE GOLD STAR MEMORIALIZING THAT THE MEMBER WAS KILLED IN ACTION; OR

(2) <u>A FIRE FIGHTER, LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, OR ANOTHER</u> <u>EMERGENCY RESPONDER WHO DIED IN THE LINE OF DUTY</u>".
