AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 426

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Waiver of”; strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 3 down through “waive” in line 4 and substitute “providing that an applicant who is a resident of the State meets”; strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 6 down through “waive” in line 7 and substitute “providing that an applicant who is a resident of the State meets”; strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 9 down through “waive” in line 10 and substitute “providing that an applicant who is a resident of the State meets”; strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 12 down through “waive” in line 13 and substitute “providing that an applicant who is a resident of the State meets”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 14 down through “circumstances;” in line 17; in line 17, strike “waivers of”; and in line 26, strike “and (13)(iv)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 14, strike “1.”; strike beginning with “registered” in line 16 down through “made” in line 17 and substitute “RESIDENT OF THE STATE”; in line 18, strike “2.”; strike beginning with “registered” in line 19 down through “made” in line 20 and substitute “RESIDENT OF THE STATE”; strike in their entirety lines 21 through 24, inclusive; and strike beginning with “ON” in line 32 down through “WAIVE” in line 34 and substitute “AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE MEETS”.

On page 3, strike beginning with “ON” in line 12 down through “WAIVE” in line 14 and substitute “AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE MEETS”.

On page 4, strike beginning with “ON” in line 1 down through “WAIVE” in line 3 and substitute “AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE MEETS”; and strike in their entirety lines 5 through 18, inclusive.
