A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Cedar Hope Chests – Prohibition on Manufacture, Import, and Sale 3 (McKenna's Law)

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from manufacturing, importing, selling, or offering for sale a cedar hope chest; providing for certain penalties; exempting from certain $\mathbf{5}$ 6 penalties the sale or distribution of a cedar hope chest that is resold, offered for 7 resale, or distributed by a consumer for consumer use; authorizing a court to enjoin 8 certain actions; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to develop 9 and implement a certain public awareness program and to adopt certain regulations; 10 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the manufacture, import, and sale 11 of cedar hope chests.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
