6	(II)	A DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS;
7	(III)	A NAVY CROSS;
8	(IV)	AN AIR FORCE CROSS;

11	(VII)	A PURPLE HEART;
12	(VIII)	A COMBAT INFANTRYMAN'S BADGE;
