- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	(a)	In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) "Billiard table" includes a pool table.

2 (c) "Billiard table license" means a license issued by the clerk to keep a billiard 3 table for commercial use.]

5 (a) This subtitle does not apply in Washington County.

6 (b) This subtitle does not impair the right of Baltimore City or a municipal 7 corporation of the State to impose a tax on billiard tables.]

8 [17-503.

9 A person must have a billiard table license whenever the person keeps a billiard 10 table for commercial use in the State.]

11 [17–504.

12 An applicant for a billiard table license shall pay to the clerk a license fee of:

(1) \$10 for each billiard table in a county other than Baltimore City,
Baltimore County, or Cecil County;

15 (2) \$20 for each billiard table in Cecil County; or

16 (3) \$40 for each billiard table in Baltimore City.]

18 (a) A person may not keep a billiard table for commercial use unless the person 19 has a billiard table license.

20 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on 21 conviction, is subject to a fine of \$500 for each billiard table kept for commercial use in 22 violation of this section.]

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2016.
