BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 18–1702 Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 18-1702.There is a scholarship program known as the Walter Sondheim Jr. Public Service Internship Scholarship Program in the State.

(h) The Shriver Center shall serve as a clearinghouse for public and nonprofit entities that wish to hire public service interns participating in the Program.
