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## Anne Arundel <u>County — County Board of Education and</u> School Board Nominating Commission— <del>Membership</del>

FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the School Board Nominating Commission of Anne Arundel County to provide that, beginning on a certain date and every certain number of years thereafter, one member shall be appointed by certain chambers of commerce on a rotating basis in a specified order; altering the term of the member appointed by a chamber of commerce; requiring each member of the Commission to be a resident of Anne Arundel County; prohibiting, with a certain exception, a member of the Commission from being an employee of a county school board; altering the method of selecting and the term of the chair of the Commission; authorizing the reappointment of a member of the Commission; specifying the terms of certain members of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the Commission from serving more than a certain number of years; altering the entity required to provide staff for the Commission; requiring the affirmative vote of a certain number of members of the Commission for the approval of any action; prohibiting a member of the Commission from voting by proxy; requiring the Commission to require each applicant for a certain nomination to complete an application that includes certain information and a certain declaration; requiring the Commission to consult the Maryland Judiciary Case Search to verify certain statements; requiring a certain member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to resign effective a certain number of days after certification of certain election results; prohibiting a certain member of the Board from continuing to serve under certain circumstances; providing for the termination of the term of a certain member terms of certain
