- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - Criminal Law

- 15 **[**10–703.
- 16 (a) This section applies to a flag of the United States or of this State, or a flag that 17 is authorized by law of the United States or of this State.
- 18 (b) For exhibition or display, a person may not place or cause to be placed a word, 19 figure, mark, picture, design, or advertisement of any nature on a flag.
- 20 (c) A person may not publicly exhibit a flag with a word, figure, mark, picture, design, or advertisement printed, painted, or produced on or attached to the flag.

- (d) A person may not publicly display for sale, manufacture, or otherwise, or sell, give, or possess for sale or for use as a gift or for any other purpose, an article of merchandise or receptacle on which a flag is produced or attached to advertise, decorate, or mark the merchandise.
- 5 (e) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction 6 is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2016.
