A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Registration Plates – Truck**
3 **Eligibility**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain weight restriction on a Class E (truck) vehicle for
5 eligibility for a Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Registration Plate; and generally
6 relating to the eligibility of trucks for Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Registration
7 Plates.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Transportation**

21 13–618.

22 (a) The Administration shall issue a special Chesapeake Bay Commemorative
23 Registration Plate.

1 (b) The owner of a vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not intended as
2 security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that owns the
3 vehicle considered eligible by the Administration may apply to the Administration for the
4 assignment of a commemorative registration plate under this section if the vehicle is
5 included in one of the following classes:

6 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;

7 (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle [with a manufacturer's rated capacity of one
8 ton or less];

9 (3) A Class G (trailer) vehicle; or

10 (4) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2016.
