- 1 (1) TEACHES THE MEDICAL PROCEDURE WITHOUT THE USE OF AN 2 ANIMAL; AND
- 3 (2) IS USED BY AT LEAST ONE OTHER MEDICAL SCHOOL IN THE 4 STATE.
- 5 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY 6 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING 7 \$1,000 FOR EACH ANIMAL USED.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2016.
