- 20 (A) In addition to any other duties set forth elsewhere, the Office shall:
- 21 (1) develop, coordinate, support, and maintain computer services and 22automated data processing and information systems for the General Assembly and the

- 1 (2) provide training for employees of the General Assembly and the 2 Department who use the information systems;
- 3 (3) plan for the future information systems needs of the General Assembly, 4 its staff, and the Department;
- 5 (4) as approved by the Executive Director and the Legislative Policy 6 Committee, upgrade the information systems of the General Assembly and the 7 Department; and
- 8 (5) carry out any other function required by the Executive Director.
