- person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may 17

- "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by 19

- human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- 3 (2) A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not shoot or 4 discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during school hours 5 or at a time when a school–approved activity is taking place.
- 6 (3) (i) For archery hunters in Carroll County or Frederick County, the 7 safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 50 yards from a 8 dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 9 (ii) For archery hunters in <u>ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY</u>, Harford County, or Montgomery County, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 13 (III) FOR ARCHERY HUNTERS IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE
 14 SAFETY ZONE DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION EXTENDS FOR 50
 15 YARDS FROM A DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR ANY OTHER BUILDING
 16 OR CAMP OCCUPIED BY HUMAN BEINGS IF:
- 20 **2.** A HILL OR ANY OTHER BARRIER IS BETWEEN THE
 21 HUNTER AND THE DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR OTHER OCCUPIED
 22 BUILDING OR CAMP.
- 23 (4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
