## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Office of Legislative Audits - Local School System Audits - Repeal

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the Office of Legislative Audits conduct 4 audits of certain local school systems within certain periods of time; repealing the 5 requirement for the Legislative Auditor to appoint professional staff to conduct 6 audits of local school systems; repealing the authorization for the Office of 7 Legislative Audits to have access to certain information to perform audits of local 8 school systems; repealing the requirement for the Office of Legislative Audits to 9 provide certain information to a local school system and the Joint Audit Committee following a certain review; repealing the authorization for the Joint Audit Committee 10 11 to take certain actions relating to a certain review; making conforming changes; and 12 generally relating to the repeal of audits of local school systems by the Office of Legislative Audits. 13

- 28 of the results of the review. The Legislative Auditor shall advise the Joint Audit Committee

- 30 (i) does not make a response to a recommendation;

- 1 (ii) does not indicate action to be taken in response to a 2 recommendation;
- 3 (iii) has not taken the action the local school system indicated in its 4 response to a recommendation; or
- 5 (iv) responds in a manner that is not considered appropriate to carry 6 out the recommendation.
- 7 (8) The Executive Director or the Joint Audit Committee may direct the 8 Legislative Auditor to undertake a review to determine the extent to which action has been 9 taken by a local school system to implement a report recommendation.
- 10 (9) With respect to findings and recommendations made to a local school system, the Joint Audit Committee may make recommendations to the Governor, State Superintendent of Schools, the local school governing board, or local school officials after reviewing a local school system's response to a recommended action.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 2–1220(f) of Article

  2–1220(e).
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
