### A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Kent County – Prospective Employees and Volunteers – Criminal History Records Check

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain officer in Kent County to request from the  $\mathbf{5}$ Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository of the Department of Public 6 Safety and Correctional Services a State and national criminal history records check 7 for a prospective county employee or volunteer; requiring that a certain officer 8 submit certain sets of fingerprints and fees to the Central Repository as part of the 9 application for a criminal history records check; requiring the Central Repository to 10 forward to the prospective employee or volunteer and a certain officer the prospective 11 employee's or volunteer's criminal history record information under certain 12circumstances; establishing that information obtained from the Central Repository 13 under this Act is confidential, may not be redisseminated, and may be used only for certain purposes; authorizing the subjects of a criminal history records check under 14 this Act to contest the contents of a certain printed statement issued by the Central 1516 Repository; requiring the governing body of Kent County to adopt guidelines to carry 17out this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to criminal history 18 records checks.

2 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "CENTRAL REPOSITORY" MEANS THE CRIMINAL 3 JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF 4 PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

5 (B) THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES OF KENT COUNTY MAY 6 REQUEST FROM THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY A STATE AND NATIONAL CRIMINAL 7 HISTORY RECORDS CHECK FOR A PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEE OR VOLUNTEER OF 8 KENT COUNTY.

9 (C) (1) AS PART OF THE APPLICATION FOR A CRIMINAL HISTORY 10 RECORDS CHECK, THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES OF KENT COUNTY SHALL 11 SUBMIT TO THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY:

12 (I) TWO COMPLETE SETS OF THE PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEE'S 13 OR VOLUNTEER'S LEGIBLE FINGERPRINTS TAKEN ON FORMS APPROVED BY THE 14 DIRECTOR OF THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE FEDERAL 15 BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION;

16 (II) THE FEE AUTHORIZED UNDER § 10–221(B)(7) OF THIS 17 SUBTITLE FOR ACCESS TO MARYLAND CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS; AND

18 (III) THE MANDATORY PROCESSING FEE REQUIRED BY THE 19 FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY 20 RECORDS CHECK.

21 (2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 10–201 THROUGH 10–250 OF THIS 22 SUBTITLE, THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL FORWARD TO THE PROSPECTIVE 23 EMPLOYEE OR VOLUNTEER AND THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES OF KENT 24 COUNTY THE PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEE'S OR VOLUNTEER'S CRIMINAL HISTORY 25 RECORD INFORMATION.

26 (3) INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY 27 UNDER THIS SECTION:

(I) IS CONFIDENTIAL AND MAY NOT BE REDISSEMINATED; AND

(II) MAY BE USED ONLY FOR A PERSONNEL-RELATED PURPOSE
 CONCERNING A PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEE OR VOLUNTEER FOR THE COUNTY AS
 AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION.

1 (4) THE SUBJECT OF A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK UNDER 2 THIS SECTION MAY CONTEST THE CONTENTS OF THE PRINTED STATEMENT ISSUED 3 BY THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY AS PROVIDED IN § 10–223 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

4 (D) THE GOVERNING BODY OF KENT COUNTY SHALL ADOPT GUIDELINES TO 5 CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2016.
