1 AN ACT concerning

Criminal Law – Synthetic Drugs – Penalties

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from purchasing, using, or possessing certain synthetic drugs; prohibiting a person from distributing certain synthetic drugs under 4 $\mathbf{5}$ certain circumstances; providing certain factors to be considered when determining 6 whether a product is being distributed as a certain synthetic drug; establishing 7 penalties for a violation of this Act; providing that a person who violates this Act 8 shall be ordered to pay certain administrative fees and costs; providing that property 9 seized in connection with enforcement of this Act is subject to forfeiture in accordance with certain provisions of law; providing for the application of this Act; defining 1011 certain terms; and generally relating to synthetic drugs.



(1) THE PRODUCT IS NOT SUITABLE FOR ITS MARKETED USE;

10 (2) THE PERSON PROVIDING, DISTRIBUTING, DISPLAYING, OR 11 SELLING THE PRODUCT DOES NOT TYPICALLY PROVIDE, DISTRIBUTE, OR SELL 12 PRODUCTS THAT ARE USED FOR THAT PRODUCT'S MARKETED USE;

13 (3) THE PRODUCT CONTAINS A WARNING LABEL THAT IS NOT 14 TYPICALLY PRESENT ON PRODUCTS THAT ARE USED FOR THAT PRODUCT'S 15 MARKETED USE, INCLUDING "NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION", "NOT FOR 16 PURCHASE BY MINORS", "MUST BE 18 YEARS OR OLDER TO PURCHASE", "100% 17 LEGAL BLEND", OR SIMILAR STATEMENTS;

18(4) THE PRODUCT IS SIGNIFICANTLY MORE EXPENSIVE THAN19PRODUCTS THAT ARE USED FOR THAT PRODUCT'S MARKETED USE; OR

(5) THE PRODUCT RESEMBLES AN ILLICIT STREET DRUG.

(E) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS
 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT
 NOT EXCEEDING 60 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.

 25 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT

27(3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION SHALL BE ORDERED TO28PAY ALL ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND COSTS TO THE DESIGNATED LAW29ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR THE CHEMICAL TESTING OF THE SUBSTANCE30COLLECTED AS EVIDENCE AND ANY OTHER COSTS ARISING FROM THE TESTING.

1 (4) PROPERTY SEIZED IN CONNECTION WITH ENFORCEMENT OF THIS 2 SECTION IS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 12 OF THE 3 CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2016.
