BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Tax - Property 14-816. If abandoned property in Baltimore City CONSISTING OF EITHER A VACANT LOT OR IMPROVED PROPERTY CITED AS VACANT AND UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ON A HOUSING OR BUILDING VIOLATION NOTICE sold under [§ 14–817(c) of] this subtitle [with a minimum bid less than the lien amount] is subject to a ground rent or lease for a term of 99 years renewable forever, the collector shall sell the whole fee simple interest in the property.
