3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to develop a certain set 4 of best practices that the Department and certain local school systems must consider $\mathbf{5}$ under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to ensure that certain best 6 practices include certain principles; requiring the Department and each local school 7 system to conduct a certain audit of certain assessments: encouraging the Department and certain local school systems to apply for certain federal funds to 8 9 conduct certain audits; and generally relating to best practices for the administration 10 of assessments in public schools.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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1 **(I)** IS DESIGNED TO INFORM INSTRUCTION OR HAVE A CLEAR $\mathbf{2}$ **PURPOSE; AND** 3 **(II) ALLOWS** FOR INDIVIDUALIZATION OF **STUDENT** 4 **INSTRUCTION.** $\mathbf{5}$ (3) IN ADDITION TO CONSIDERATIONS ADDRESSED IN PARAGRAPH (1) 6 OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF AN ASSESSMENT OR TEST IS A SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT OR 7 TEST, THE BEST PRACTICES SHALL CONSIDER IF THE ASSESSMENT OR TEST WILL BE 8 USED ONLY FOR ACCOUNTABILITY PURPOSES FOR TEACHER AND PRINCIPAL EVALUATIONS OR STUDENT LEARNING OBJECTIVES. 9 10 (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF ALL (C) 11 STATE-MANDATED ASSESSMENTS THAT ARE ADMINISTERED IN THE STATE TO 12ENSURE CONFORMITY WITH THE BEST PRACTICES DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION. 1314 (2) EACH LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF ALL 15LOCALLY MANDATED ASSESSMENTS THAT ARE ADMINISTERED IN THE LOCAL 16 SCHOOL SYSTEM TO ENSURE CONFORMITY WITH THE BEST PRACTICES DEVELOPED 17**UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.** SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Department of 18 Education and local school systems are encouraged to apply for federal funds to audit State 19

and local assessment systems.
