BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Transportation Section 10–204 Title III Article III Section 5(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation 10-204.

- 3 (a) The Authority shall be governed by a Board of eight Directors consisting of 4 two Directors for each signatory and two for the federal government (one of whom shall be 5 a regular passenger and customer of the bus or rail service of the Authority). For Virginia, 6 the Directors shall be appointed by the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission; for 7 the District of Columbia, by the Council of the District of Columbia; for Maryland, by the 8 Washington Suburban Transit Commission; and for the federal government, by the [Administrator of General Services] U.S. SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION 9 SECRETARY OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. For 10 11 Virginia and Maryland, the Directors shall be appointed from among the members of the appointing body, except as otherwise provided herein, and shall serve for a term coincident 12 13 with their term on the appointing body. A Director for a signatory may be removed or 14 suspended from office only as provided by the law of the signatory from which he was appointed. The nonfederal appointing authorities shall also appoint an alternate for each 15 Director. In addition, the [Administrator of General Services] U.S. SECRETARY OF 16 TRANSPORTATION SECRETARY OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF 17 18 TRANSPORTATION shall also appoint two nonvoting members who shall serve as the 19 alternates for the federal Directors. An alternate Director may act only in the absence of 20 the Director for whom he has been appointed an alternate, except that, in the case of the District of Columbia where only one Director and his alternate are present, such alternate 21 22may act on behalf of the absent Director. Each alternate, including the federal nonvoting 23Directors, shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority. In the event of a vacancy 24in the Office of Director or alternate, it shall be filled in the same manner as an original 25 appointment.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2016.
