BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 11 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 Article - Alcoholic Beverages 9-1902.14 15 (a) A license holder may employ an individual between the ages of 18 and 21 16 years. 17 To be allowed to sell or serve beer [and], light wine, AND LIQUOR, an individual shall be at least 18 years old. 18 19 (c) To be allowed to sell or serve liquor, an individual shall be at least 21 years old. 20 21SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 221, 2016.
