SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 13 Article Alcoholic Beverages
- 14 9–1902.
- 15 (a) A license holder may employ an individual between the ages of 18 and 21 16 years.

17 (b) To be allowed to sell or serve beer [and], light wine, AND LIQUOR, an 18 individual shall be at least 18 years old.
