17(A) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT FOR DRAFT18BEER TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS B OR CLASS H LICENSE.

19(B) THE HOURS OF SALE FOR A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT BEGIN AT20THE SAME TIME FOR THE UNDERLYING LICENSE AND END AT MIDNIGHT.

21 (C) THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE IS \$500.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 23 1, 2016.
