A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Anne Arundel County Public Schools – Adjunct Instructor Program

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to establish 4 and implement an adjunct instructor program to meet the demand for gualified $\mathbf{5}$ individuals to provide instruction in certain grades and certain subject areas; 6 requiring the Board, if it exercises certain authority, to make certain determinations, 7 employ certain individuals as adjunct instructors on a part-time basis under certain 8 contracts, and issue certain certificates; establishing the qualifications for 9 certification as an adjunct instructor; authorizing an adjunct instructor to provide 10 instruction in a certain subject area; establishing the authority of an adjunct 11 instructor to supervise and manage a classroom, maintain and handle student 12records, and evaluate student performance and assign course grades; requiring an 13adjunct instructor certificate to specify the authorized subject area of instruction, be 14 valid for a certain time period, and be renewable; prohibiting the transfer of an 15adjunct instructor certificate; defining certain terms; and generally relating to an 16adjunct instructor program in the Anne Arundel County Public Schools.

(A) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 1 (1) $\mathbf{2}$ INDICATED. 3 (2) "ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO: 4 DOES NOT HAVE AN EDUCATOR CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY **(I)** $\mathbf{5}$ THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; 6 **(II)** HAS SPECIFIC KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND EXPERIENCE IN A 7 SPECIALTY OR HARD-TO-FILL SUBJECT AREA, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY 8 **BOARD; AND** 9 (III) IS EMPLOYED ON A PART-TIME BASIS, UNDER A SHORT-TERM RENEWABLE CONTRACT, TO PROVIDE INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES IN A 10 PUBLIC SCHOOL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. 11 12"COUNTY BOARD" MEANS THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD (3) 13OF EDUCATION. THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY. 14**(B)** 15THE COUNTY BOARD MAY ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT AN ADJUNCT **(C)** 16 INSTRUCTOR PROGRAM TO MEET THE DEMAND FOR QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS TO PROVIDE INSTRUCTION IN GRADES 6 THROUGH 12 IN SPECIALTY AND OTHER 17 18 HARD-TO-FILL SUBJECT AREAS, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD, 19 **INCLUDING:** 20(1) SCIENCE-, TECHNOLOGY-, ENGINEERING-, OR MATH-BASED

IN THE SUBJECT AREAS IDENTIFIED UNDER ITEM (1) OF 1 **(I)** $\mathbf{2}$ THIS SUBSECTION; AND 3 (II) ON A PART-TIME BASIS UNDER A RENEWABLE CONTRACT FOR A TERM OF UP TO 1 YEAR: 4 $\mathbf{5}$ (3) **ISSUE AN ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATE TO AN INDIVIDUAL** 6 EMPLOYED UNDER ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND 7 (4) Ensure that an adjunct instructor does not provide 8 INSTRUCTION FOR MORE THAN 50% OF A SCHOOL DAY. 9 **(E)** TO QUALIFY FOR CERTIFICATION AS AN ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR, AN 10 **INDIVIDUAL SHALL:** 11 (1) (I) **BE EMPLOYED IN OR RETIRED FROM AN INDUSTRY OR A** 12PROFESSION RELATED TO THE SPECIALTY OR OTHER AREA IN WHICH THE **INDIVIDUAL WILL BE CERTIFIED; OR** 13 14HAVE INSTRUCTIONAL EXPERIENCE IN A BRANCH OF THE **(II)** 15**UNITED STATES MILITARY;** 16 HOLD A CURRENT LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE IN GOOD STANDING (2) 17FOR THE RELATED INDUSTRY OR PROFESSION, IF APPLICABLE; 18 (3) HAVE AT LEAST 3 YEARS OF VERIFIED EXPERIENCE IN THE 19RELATED INDUSTRY OR PROFESSION OR AS AN INSTRUCTOR IN THE UNITED STATES 20MILITARY; AND 21(4) AGREE TO COMPLETE, WITHIN 3 YEARS AFTER APPLYING FOR THE 22ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR PROGRAM, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD, 9 23**CREDIT HOURS IN:** 24**(I) PEDAGOGY;** 25(II) CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT; AND 26(III) THE POLICIES, REGULATIONS, AND PRACTICES OF THE **ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS.** 2728**(F)** AN ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR MAY PROVIDE INSTRUCTION IN:

1 (1) THE SUBJECT AREA SPECIFIED ON THE ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR 2 CERTIFICATE; OR

3 (2) A CRITICAL SHORTAGE AREA THAT IS NOT THE SUBJECT AREA 4 SPECIFIED ON THE ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATE, AS DETERMINED TO BE 5 NECESSARY BY THE COUNTY BOARD.

6 (G) AN ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR SHALL HAVE THE SAME AUTHORITY AS A 7 CERTIFICATED TEACHER FOR THE PURPOSES OF:

8 (1) SUPERVISING AND MANAGING A CLASSROOM;

9 (2) MAINTAINING AND HANDLING STUDENT RECORDS; AND

10(3) EVALUATING STUDENT PERFORMANCE AND ASSIGNING COURSE11GRADES.

12 (H) AN ADJUNCT INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATE:

13(1)SHALL SPECIFY THE AUTHORIZED SUBJECT AREA OF14INSTRUCTION;

15 (2) SHALL BE VALID FOR UP TO 1 YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE;

- 16 (3) MAY BE RENEWED; AND
- 17 (4) MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June1, 2016.

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
