16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That Section(s) 7–412 through 7–416, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the
18 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–413 through 7–417,
19 respectively.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
21 as follows:

22 **Article – General Provisions**

1 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “LAST DAY OF SPRING” MEANS THE DAY BEFORE THE**
2 **SUMMER SOLSTICE.**

3 **(B) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE LAST DAY OF SPRING**
4 **AS FARMERS’ DAY.**

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2016.
