3 (B) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE LAST DAY OF SPRING 4 AS FARMERS' DAY.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2016.
