- 18 (a) There is a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license.
- 19 (b) The Board may issue the license for use by a restaurant, motel, or hotel that 20 has a facility:
- 21 (1) for serving full–course meals at least twice daily; and

1 (2) with seating at tables for at least [50] **25** individuals, not including 2 seats at bars or counters.

3 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at the 4 place described in the license for on-premises consumption.

5 (d) The annual license fee is \$1,000.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2016.
