A BILL ENTITLED

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Division of Workforce Development and Adult Learning – Job Training Grant Program – Establishment

FOR the purpose of establishing the Job Training Grant Program in the Division of 4 5 Workforce Development and Adult Learning; stating the purpose of the Program; 6 requiring a nonprofit organization to meet certain requirements in order to be 7 eligible for a grant under the Program; requiring the Division to take certain actions 8 regarding the Program; requiring a grantee to submit certain annual reports to the 9 Division for the life of the grant; providing that a grantee who fails to meet certain performance goals is barred from applying to renew the grant for a certain time 10 11 period; requiring a certain grantee, under certain circumstances, to submit a full 12 application and a certain action plan; requiring the Governor, beginning in a certain 13 fiscal year, and for each fiscal year thereafter, to include a certain amount in the 14 budget bill to fund the Program; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Job Training Grant Program. 15

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Labor and Employment
- 24 **11–604.**

- 1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 2 INDICATED.
- 3 (2) "DIVISION" MEANS THE DIVISION OF WORKFORCE 4 DEVELOPMENT AND ADULT LEARNING.
- 5 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE JOB TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM 6 ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 7 (B) THERE IS A JOB TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM IN THE DIVISION.
- 8 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE 3-YEAR GRANTS TO 9 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE JOB TRAINING TO:
- 10 (1) INDIVIDUALS WHOSE INCOME IS NOT MORE THAN 200% OF THE 11 FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES;
- 12 (2) INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES;
- 13 (3) DISLOCATED WORKERS;
- 14 (4) UNEMPLOYED OR UNDEREMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS;
- 15 **(5) VETERANS**;
- 16 (6) INDIVIDUALS FORMERLY INCARCERATED; AND
- 17 (7) ANY OTHER POPULATION GROUP IDENTIFIED BY THE DIVISION.
- 18 (D) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT UNDER THE PROGRAM, A NONPROFIT 19 ORGANIZATION SHALL:
- 20 (1) PROVIDE JOB TRAINING IN WHICH AT LEAST 80% OF NEW
- 21 PARTICIPANTS IN A CALENDAR YEAR ARE MEMBERS OF GROUPS LISTED UNDER
- 22 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION;
- 23 (2) REQUIRE JOB TRAINING PARTICIPANTS TO COMPLETE
- 24 ATTITUDINAL TRAINING THAT FOCUSES ON JOB RETENTION AND APPROPRIATE
- 25 EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE INTERACTIONS;
- 26 (3) PROVIDE AT LEAST 2 YEARS OF CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO
- 27 PARTICIPANTS THAT COMPLETE THE JOB TRAINING AND ARE PLACED IN A JOB;

- 1 (4) COMMIT TO PROVIDING MATCHING FUNDS EQUAL TO 25% OF THE
- 2 GRANT AMOUNT ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (E)(1) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 3 (5) MEET ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE 4 DIVISION.
- 5 (E) THE DIVISION SHALL:
- 6 (1) ESTABLISH A SET GRANT AMOUNT THAT WILL BE AWARDED TO 7 EACH GRANTEE UNDER THE PROGRAM;
- 8 (2) DISTRIBUTE GRANT MONEY TO A GRANTEE IN YEARLY 9 INSTALLMENTS FOR THE LIFE OF THE GRANT;
- 10 (3) SET PROGRAM PERFORMANCE GOALS THAT AGGREGATE THE 11 PERFORMANCE OF THE GRANTEES OVER THE LIFE OF THE GRANT;
- 12 (4) ESTABLISH A SHORTER REAPPLICATION PROCESS THAT A
- 13 GRANTEE THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS PERFORMANCE GOALS MAY USE TO APPLY TO
- 14 RENEW THE GRANT; AND
- 15 (5) ADOPT ANY REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES NECESSARY TO 16 CARRY OUT THE PROGRAM.
- 17 (F) A GRANTEE SHALL SUBMIT ANNUAL REPORTS TO THE DIVISION FOR
- 18 THE LIFE OF THE GRANT THAT CONTAIN ANY INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE
- 19 **DIVISION.**
- 20 (G) A GRANTEE THAT FAILS TO MEET THE PERFORMANCE GOALS SET 21 UNDER SUBSECTION (E)(3) OF THIS SECTION:
- 22 (1) IS BARRED FROM APPLYING TO RENEW THE GRANT FOR A PERIOD 23 OF 1 YEAR FOLLOWING THE FINAL YEAR OF THE GRANT; AND
- 24 (2) IF THE GRANTEE DECIDES TO APPLY TO RENEW THE GRANT AFTER
- 25 THE 1-YEAR PERIOD, SHALL SUBMIT A FULL APPLICATION AND AN ACTION PLAN
- 26 DETAILING HOW THE TRAINING SERVICES WILL BE IMPROVED TO MEET THE
- 27 PERFORMANCE GOALS.
- 28 (H) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2018, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR
- 29 THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE BUDGET BILL AT LEAST
- 30 **\$500,000** TO FUND THE PROGRAM.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
