3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain organizations in Anne Arundel County to conduct 4 a card game, card tournament, or casino event under certain circumstances;  $\mathbf{5}$ requiring an organization to obtain a permit from the County Department of 6 Inspections and Permits before conducting a card game, card tournament, or casino 7 event; requiring an organization that seeks a permit to meet certain requirements; 8 specifying that a card game, card tournament, or casino event may be managed and 9 organized by certain organizations; requiring an individual who participates in or 10 volunteers as an operator of a card game, card tournament, or casino event to be of 11 a certain age; specifying that a permit holder may receive a certain maximum 12number of permits in a calendar year; providing a certain time limit on a card game, 13 card tournament, or casino event; specifying that a permit is not transferable; 14requiring that proceeds from a card game, card tournament, or casino event be used 15for certain purposes and may not be used for certain other purposes subject to a 16certain exception; specifying that the operation of a card game, card tournament, or 17casino event may not occur during a certain time; authorizing a permit holder under this Act to charge only a preset entrance fee; requiring participants in a card game, 18 19card tournament, or casino event to use tokens and not cash for wagering under 20certain circumstances; authorizing the serving or sale of alcoholic beverages under 21certain circumstances; prohibiting a permit holder from exchanging tokens under 22certain circumstances; requiring a permit holder to submit a financial report and 23certain information about winners of certain prizes to the County Department of 24Inspections and Permits under certain circumstances; authorizing the County 25Executive and County Council to adopt certain regulations; providing a certain 26penalty; defining certain terms; and generally relating to gaming in Anne Arundel 27County.

 is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or both.
