1 AN ACT concerning

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Income Tax Checkoff – Maryland Veterans Trust Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a certain income tax checkoff system for voluntary 4 contributions to the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund; requiring the Comptroller to include a checkoff on the individual income tax return; providing that the income tax $\mathbf{5}$ 6 checkoff system include a certain statement; requiring the Comptroller to include 7 certain information in each individual income tax return package; requiring the 8 Comptroller to collect and account for contributions made through the checkoff 9 system and to credit the proceeds to the Fund after deducting the amount necessary 10 to administer the checkoff system; providing that the Fund may consist of certain 11 contributions from the income tax checkoff system and certain other money; 12providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to an income tax 13checkoff system for contributions to the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund.
