## Public Service Commission - Damaged or Dangling Utility Lines - Fine

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission to notify a certain person about a damaged or dangling line on a utility pole under certain circumstances; requiring a certain person to investigate and, where appropriate, repair a damaged or dangling line within a certain period after receiving notice from the Commission; requiring the Commission to impose a certain fine on a certain person that fails to repair a damaged or dangling line within a certain period; and generally relating to damaged or dangling lines on utility poles.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) IF AN INDIVIDUAL NOTIFIES THE COMMISSION OF A DAMAGED OR
- 20 DANGLING LINE ON A UTILITY POLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL PROMPTLY NOTIFY
- 21 THE PERSON THAT CONTROLS THE LINE ABOUT THE DAMAGED OR DANGLING LINE.

- 1 (B) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE FROM THE COMMISSION, 2 THE PERSON THAT CONTROLS THE LINE SHALL INVESTIGATE AND, WHERE 3 APPROPRIATE, REPAIR THE DAMAGED OR DANGLING LINE.
- 4 (C) IF THE LINE IS NOT REPAIRED WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE COMMISSION
  5 NOTIFIES THE PERSON THAT CONTROLS THE LINE ABOUT THE DAMAGED OR
  6 DANGLING LINE, THE COMMISSION SHALL IMPOSE A FINE OF UP TO \$250 ON THE
  7 PERSON THAT CONTROLS THE LINE FOR EACH 30-DAY PERIOD THAT THE LINE
  8 REMAINS DAMAGED OR DANGLING.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2016.
