1 AN ACT concerning

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Vehicle Laws - Plug-In Electric Drive Vehicles - Reserved Parking Spaces

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from stopping, standing, or parking a vehicle that is not a plug-in electric drive vehicle connected for charging purposes in a parking 4 5 space that is designated in a certain manner for the use of plug-in electric drive 6 vehicles; establishing certain standards for signage designating reserved parking for 7 certain plug-in electric drive vehicles; requiring that a parking space that is for the 8 use of plug-in electric drive vehicles have certain payement markings; authorizing 9 a parking facility to have a vehicle that is stopped, standing, or parked in violation 10 of this Act towed or removed under certain circumstances and subject to certain 11 standards and requirements; requiring that a parking space that is for the use of 12 plug-in electric drive vehicles be counted in a certain way for complying with certain 13 laws intended to meet certain requirements under the Americans with Disabilities 14 Act; defining a certain term; establishing a civil penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to reserved parking spaces for plug-in electric drive vehicles. 15
