- 2 (a) There is a Class C [(Maryland Ensemble Theatre)] (THEATER) beer and wine
- 3 license.
- 4 (b) (1) The president and two other officers of the [Maryland Ensemble
- 5 Theatre] **THEATER** shall sign the application for the license.
- 6 (2) Two of the signers shall be residents of the County.
- 7 (c) The Board may issue a license for use by [the Maryland Ensemble Theatre] A 8 THEATER WITH SEATING FOR 200 OR FEWER INDIVIDUALS PER PERFORMANCE.
- 9 (d) [The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine for 10 on-premises consumption.
- 11 (e) The license [holder may] AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO sell beer and wine for on–premises consumption from 1 hour before to 1 hour after:
- 13 (1) a regular performance; or
- 14 (2) a fund-raiser performance that benefits the [Maryland Ensemble 15 Theatre] THEATER.
- 16 [(f)] **(E)** The annual license fee is \$100.
