1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Theater License**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the scope of a certain alcoholic beverages license in Frederick
4 County so that it may be issued to all theaters that meet a certain seating
5 requirement; making a certain technical correction; and generally relating to
6 alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That Section(s) 20–1008, 20–1009, 20–1010, 20–1011, 20–1012, and 20–1013, respectively,

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
4 as follows:

5 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

6 20–1013.

7 (a) There is a Class C [(Maryland Ensemble Theatre)] **(THEATER)** beer and wine
8 license.

9 (b) (1) The president and two other officers of the [Maryland Ensemble
10 Theatre] **THEATER** shall sign the application for the license.

11 (2) Two of the signers shall be residents of the County.

12 (c) The Board may issue a license for use by [the Maryland Ensemble Theatre] **A**
13 **THEATER WITH SEATING FOR 200 OR FEWER INDIVIDUALS PER PERFORMANCE.**

14 (d) [The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine for
15 on–premises consumption.

16 (e) The license [holder may] **AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO** sell beer
17 and wine for on–premises consumption from 1 hour before to 1 hour after:

18 (1) a regular performance; or

19 (2) a fund–raiser performance that benefits the [Maryland Ensemble
20 Theatre] **THEATER.**

21 **[(f)] (E)** The annual license fee is \$100.

22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
23 1, 2016.
