- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

16 **21–1130**.

(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON
MAY NOT CAUSE A DIESEL-POWERED MOTOR VEHICLE TO DISCHARGE EXCESS
SMOKE, SOOT, OR OTHER EXHAUST EMISSIONS ONTO ANOTHER PERSON OR MOTOR
VEHICLE.

21 **(B)** THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON OPERATING A 22 DIESEL–POWERED VEHICLE THAT DISCHARGES VISIBLE EXHAUST AS THE RESULT 23 OF TOWING.
