3 FOR the purpose of requiring a municipality to establish a procedure for resolving a tie
4 vote in an election for a municipal officer; providing that a certain election procedure
5 may be established by ordinance or charter amendment; and generally relating to tie
6 votes in municipal elections.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Local Government**

15 **4–108.4.**

16 **(A) A MUNICIPALITY SHALL ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE FOR RESOLVING A**
17 **TIE VOTE IN AN ELECTION FOR A MUNICIPAL OFFICER.**
