A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City Police Department – Training Requirements – Eviction**
3 **Procedures**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Professional Development and Training Academy of the
5 Baltimore City Police Department to require that certain entrance–level and annual
6 in–service level training include certain training regarding eviction procedures;
7 requiring the training to be developed in cooperation with the Office of the Attorney
8 General and the Office of the Sheriff of Baltimore City and conducted by the Office
9 of the Sheriff of Baltimore City; and generally relating to training requirements for
10 law enforcement officers of the Baltimore City Police Department.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Public Safety**

19 **3–514.**

20 **(A) THE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING ACADEMY OF THE**
21 **BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE, FOR ENTRANCE–LEVEL**
22 **POLICE TRAINING AND ANNUALLY FOR IN–SERVICE LEVEL POLICE TRAINING, THAT**
23 **THE CURRICULUM AND MINIMUM COURSES OF STUDY INCLUDE TRAINING**
24 **REGARDING EVICTION PROCEDURES.**

1 **(B) THE TRAINING REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION**
2 **SHALL BE:**

3 **(1) DEVELOPED WITH THE COOPERATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE**
4 **ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE CITY; AND**

5 **(2) CONDUCTED BY THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE**
6 **CITY.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2016.
