## A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Behavioral Health Administration – Creation and Maintenance of Mental Health Professional Profiles (Patient Protection Provider Information Act)

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of requiring the Behavioral Health Administration to create and maintain 6 public individual profiles for certain mental health professionals that include certain 7 information; requiring the Administration to provide a mechanism for the 8 notification and prompt correction of factual inaccuracies in certain profiles; 9 requiring the State Board of Physicians and the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists to provide promptly to the Administration certain 10 11 information required for the creation and maintenance of certain profiles; defining 12certain terms; and generally relating to the creation and maintenance of mental 13 health professional profiles by the Behavioral Health Administration.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Health - General

4 **7.5–207.** 

5 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 6 INDICATED.

7 (2) "COUNSELOR" MEANS A COUNSELOR CERTIFIED OR LICENSED BY
8 THE STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS AND THERAPISTS UNDER
9 TITLE 17 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

10 (3) "MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL" MEANS A PHYSICIAN, 11 COUNSELOR, OR THERAPIST WHO PROVIDES MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES TO 12 INDIVIDUALS IN THE STATE.

13(4) "PHYSICIAN" MEANS A PHYSICIAN LICENSED BY THE STATE14BOARD OF PHYSICIANS UNDER TITLE 14 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

15 (5) "THERAPIST" MEANS A THERAPIST WHO IS CERTIFIED OR 16 LICENSED BY THE STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS AND 17 THERAPISTS UNDER TITLE 17 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

18**(B)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL CREATE AND MAINTAIN A PUBLIC19INDIVIDUAL PROFILE ON EACH MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL THAT INCLUDES:

(1) IF THE MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL IS A PHYSICIAN, THE
INFORMATION INCLUDED IN THE PHYSICIAN'S PUBLIC INDIVIDUAL PROFILE
CREATED AND MAINTAINED BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHYSICIANS UNDER §
14-411.1(B) OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE; AND

24(2)IF THE MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL IS A COUNSELOR OR25THERAPIST:

(I) A SUMMARY OF CHARGES FILED AGAINST THE COUNSELOR
OR THERAPIST, INCLUDING A COPY OF THE CHARGING DOCUMENT, UNTIL THE
STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS AND THERAPISTS HAS TAKEN
ACTION UNDER § 17–509 OR § 17–6A–19 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE
BASED ON THE CHARGES OR HAS RESCINDED THE CHARGES;

A DESCRIPTION OF ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION TAKEN BY

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THE COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST WITHIN THE MOST RECENT 10-YEAR PERIOD THAT **INCLUDES A COPY OF THE PUBLIC ORDER;** (III) A DESCRIPTION IN SUMMARY FORM OF ANY FINAL DISCIPLINARY ACTION TAKEN BY A LICENSING BOARD IN ANY OTHER STATE OR JURISDICTION AGAINST THE COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST WITHIN THE MOST RECENT **10–YEAR PERIOD; AND** (IV) **POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION** AND PRACTICE INFORMATION ABOUT THE COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST INCLUDING: 1. THE NAME OF ANY POSTSECONDARY SCHOOL AT WHICH THE COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST TOOK COURSE WORK TO FULFILL APPLICABLE CERTIFICATION OR LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS AND, IF APPLICABLE, THE DATE ON WHICH THE COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST GRADUATED FROM THE SCHOOL; 2. A DESCRIPTION OF ANY SUPERVISED TRAINING COMPLETED BY THE COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST; 3. THE **COUNSELOR'S** LOCATION OF THE OR THERAPIST'S PRIMARY PRACTICE SETTING; AND 4. WHETHER THE **COUNSELOR** OR THERAPIST PARTICIPATES IN THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. **(C)** THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE A MECHANISM FOR THE NOTIFICATION AND PROMPT CORRECTION OF ANY FACTUAL INACCURACIES IN A MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL'S PROFILE. **Article – Health Occupations** 14 - 101.(b)"Board" means the State Board of Physicians. 14-411.1. The Board: (d) (1)On receipt of a written request for a licensee's profile from any person, shall forward a written copy of the profile to the person;

1 (2) Shall maintain a Web site that serves as a single point of entry where 2 all physician profile information is available to the public on the Internet; [and]

3 (3) On receipt of a verbal, electronic, or written request in accordance with 4 subsection (c)(3) of this section, shall provide the information within 2 business days of the 5 request; AND

6 (4) SHALL PROVIDE PROMPTLY TO THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH 7 ADMINISTRATION ANY INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR THE CREATION AND 8 MAINTENANCE OF MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL PROFILES UNDER § 7.5–207 OF 9 THE HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE.

13 (b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:

14 (1) Maintain a registry of all counselors or therapists currently licensed or 15 certified by the Board and all individuals currently working as trainees in accordance with 16 § 17–406(b) of this title;

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(2) Submit an annual report to the Governor and the Secretary;

18 (3) Adopt a code of ethics that the Board considers to be appropriate and 19 applicable to the counselors or therapists currently certified or licensed by the Board and 20 the individuals currently working as trainees in accordance with § 17–406(b) of this title;

(4) Establish continuing education requirements for the counselors or

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2016.

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
