### 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Telemedicine – Modifications

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, under certain circumstances, to include primary care providers in the types of health care providers 4  $\mathbf{5}$ eligible to receive reimbursement for health care services that are delivered through 6 telemedicine and provided to Maryland Medical Assistance Program recipients; 7 <del>prohibiting</del> authorizing the Department from requiring to require a health care 8 provider to comply with administrative requirements for reimbursement for health 9 care services that are delivered through telemedicine that are not required for 10 reimbursement for health care services that are delivered in person submit a certain 11 form to the Department; requiring the Department, in consultation with the Maryland Health Care Commission, to provide an opportunity for stakeholders to 12participate in the development of certain regulations; requiring the Department to 13submit a draft of the regulations to certain legislative committees and provide a 14 certain period of time for review and comment submit a certain report to certain 1516committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to Maryland Medical Assistance Program reimbursement for health care 1718 services that are delivered through telemedicine.

19 20	B. That enables the patient to see and interact with the health care provider at the time the health care service is provided to the patient.

28 29 30 31	(2) To the extent authorized by federal law or regulation, the provisions of § 15–139(c) through (f) of the Insurance Article relating to coverage of and reimbursement for health care services delivered through telemedicine shall apply to the Program and managed care organizations in the same manner they apply to carriers.		
$\frac{32}{33}$	(3) Subject to the limitations of the State budget and to the extent authorized by federal law or regulation, the Department may authorize coverage of and		

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reimbursement for health care services that are delivered through store and forward
 technology or remote patient monitoring.

3 (4) (I) The Department may specify by regulation the types of health 4 care providers eligible to receive reimbursement for health care services provided to 5 Program recipients under this subsection.

6 (II) IF THE DEPARTMENT SPECIFIES BY REGULATION THE 7 TYPES OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR 8 HEALTH CARE SERVICES PROVIDED TO PROGRAM RECIPIENTS UNDER THIS 9 SUBSECTION, THE TYPES OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS SPECIFIED SHALL INCLUDE 10 PRIMARY CARE PROVIDERS.

11 (5) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT REQUIRE A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER 12TO COMPLY WITH ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING APPROVAL OF A 13 PROVIDER ADDENDUM, FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES THAT ARE DELIVERED THROUGH TELEMEDICINE THAT ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR 14REIMBURSEMENT FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES THAT ARE DELIVERED IN PERSON 15REQUIRE A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TO SUBMIT A REGISTRATION FORM TO THE 16 17DEPARTMENT THAT INCLUDES INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR THE PROCESSING OF 18 CLAIMS FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES PROVIDED TO 19 **PROGRAM RECIPIENTS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.**
