1 AN ACT concerning

2 Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Movie Theater License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class MT (movie theater) license in Harford County; authorizing the Harford County Board of License Commissioners to issue the license 4 $\mathbf{5}$ to an owner of a movie theater; requiring the owner of a movie theater to provide 6 certain documentation to the Board to be eligible for the license; specifying that the 7 license entitles the holder to sell beer and wine, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption; specifying the hours and days of sale; requiring that beer, wine, and 8 9 liquor be sold only in a certain manner; providing that a movie theater for which the 10 license is issued is subject to certain alcohol awareness training requirements and 11 shall offer for sale food other than candy and popcorn; specifying a certain annual 12 license fee; and generally relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages in Harford 13County.

2 (A) THERE IS A CLASS MT (MOVIE THEATER) BEER AND WINE, WINE, AND 3 LIQUOR LICENSE.

4 (B) (1) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY THE OWNER OF 5 A MOVIE THEATER.

6 (2) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE LICENSE, THE OWNER OF A MOVIE 7 THEATER IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION TO THE BOARD THAT THE 8 OWNER HAS MADE AN INVESTMENT OF AT LEAST \$250,000 IN THE MOVIE THEATER.

9 (C) (1) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER AND WINE, WINE, AND 10 LIQUOR FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION DURING THE SAME HOURS AND FROM 4 11 P.M. TO MIDNIGHT ON THE DAYS THAT THE MOVIE THEATER IS OPEN.

- 12 (2) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MAY BE SOLD ONLY:
- 13 (I) IN SINGLE–SERVE CONTAINERS; AND

14 (II) FROM A COUNTER SEPARATE FROM A COUNTER SERVING 15 CANDY, POPCORN, AND NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

16 (3) <u>A MOVIE THEATER FOR WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED:</u>

17(I)IS SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING18REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4–505 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

 (II)
 SHALL OFFER FOR SALE FOOD OTHER THAN CANDY AND

 20
 POPCORN.

21 (D) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 23 1, 2016.

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
