## Hard-Shell Clams - Use of Hydraulic Clam Dredge - Atlantic Coastal Bays

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a person to catch hard-shell clams by hydraulic clam 4 dredge in certain areas of the Atlantic Coastal Bays; prohibiting a person who 5 catches hard-shell clams in the Atlantic Coastal Bays from using a hydraulic clam 6 dredge that has a tooth bar that exceeds a certain length; limiting the number of 7 licensees per vessel who may catch hard-shell clams by hydraulic clam dredge in the 8 Atlantic Coastal Bays; requiring one licensee on a vessel catching hard-shell clams 9 by hydraulic clam dredge in the Atlantic Coastal Bays to be the owner and operator 10 of the vessel; establishing certain daily catch limits for and a certain season for 11 catching hard-shell clams by hydraulic clam dredge in the Atlantic Coastal Bays; and generally relating to catching hard-shell clams by hydraulic clam dredge in the 12 13 Atlantic Coastal Bays.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 21 Article - Natural Resources

- 23 **(A)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this title **AND EXCEPT FOR** 24 **SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION**, a person may not catch or attempt to catch clams or



- oysters by power dredge, hydraulic clam dredge, or other mechanical means in the Atlantic Coastal Bays, as defined in § 8–1802 of this article.
- 3 (B) A PERSON MAY CATCH HARD-SHELL CLAMS BY HYDRAULIC CLAM 4 DREDGE IN THE ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4–1021.1 OF 5 THIS SUBTITLE.

- 7 (A) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A person 8 may not catch hard–shell clams by hydraulic clam dredge or other mechanical means in 9 the Atlantic Coastal Bays, as defined in § 8–1802 of this article.
- 10 (B) (1) A PERSON MAY CATCH HARD-SHELL CLAMS BY HYDRAULIC CLAM
  11 DREDGE IN THE ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS BETWEEN THE VERRAZANO BRIDGE AND
  12 THE MARYLAND-VIRGINIA STATE LINE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION.
- 13 (2) A PERSON WHO CATCHES HARD-SHELL CLAMS UNDER THIS
  14 SUBSECTION MAY NOT USE A HYDRAULIC CLAM DREDGE THAT HAS A TOOTH BAR
  15 THAT EXCEEDS 28 INCHES IN LENGTH MEASURING FROM THE OUTSIDE EDGES.
- 16 (3) NO MORE THAN TWO LICENSEES PER VESSEL MAY CATCH
  17 HARD-SHELL CLAMS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE THE
  18 OWNER AND OPERATOR OF THE VESSEL.
- 19 (4) THE DAILY CATCH LIMIT FOR HARD-SHELL CLAMS UNDER THIS 20 SUBSECTION IS:
- 21 (I) 4,000 PER LICENSEE; AND
- 22 (II) 8,000 PER VESSEL.
- 23 (5) THE SEASON FOR CATCHING HARD-SHELL CLAMS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS FROM NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH MARCH 31 OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2016.
