7 ~~and the state in which the applicant is licensed offers a certain reciprocal licensing~~
8 ~~process; and generally relating to physician licensing reciprocity under the State~~
9 ~~Board of Physicians~~ requiring the State Board of Physicians to license certain
10 applicants to practice medicine under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to
11 adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to reciprocal licensure for
12 physicians.
