## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

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#### Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class D (Waterfront) Beer, Wine, and Liquor License

#### PG 315-16

- $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of repealing the prohibition against issuing a Class D beer, wine, and 6 liquor license in Prince George's County; establishing a Class D (waterfront) beer, 7 wine, and liquor license that the Board of License Commissioners of the County may 8 issue to an establishment in a certain waterfront entertainment retail complex; 9 establishing certain privileges for the license: authorizing certain dancing and 10 entertainment activities on certain licensed premises in a certain manner; providing 11 for the days and hours of operation of certain premises under the license; 12establishing an annual fee for the license; limiting the number of licenses that may be issued under this Act; prohibiting the entry of certain persons onto the licensed 13premises under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages 14 15licenses in Prince George's County.

6 (c) The Board may adopt regulations regarding the presence of an individual 7 under the age of 21 years on a licensed premises.
