## Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Community College License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class CC (community college) beer and wine license in 4 Harford County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license 5 to an officer of a community college for use on certain parts of the community college 6 campus; providing that the license authorizes the sale of beer and wine for 7 on-premises consumption to individuals who attend certain public events and to 8 members of certain groups and their guests who attend events held for those groups; 9 prohibiting a license holder from selling beer and wine at certain events; prohibiting a license holder from allowing alcoholic beverages to be consumed during a certain 10 11 time; prohibiting, with a certain exception, a license holder from allowing an 12 individual to carry alcoholic beverages on to or from the licensed premises; providing 13 for an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in 14 Harford County.

## **Article - Alcoholic Beverages** 1 2 22-102.3 This title applies only in Harford County. 22-807.1. 4 THERE IS A CLASS CC (COMMUNITY COLLEGE) BEER AND WINE 5 (A) 6 LICENSE. 7 THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO AN OFFICER OF A COMMUNITY 8 COLLEGE FOR USE ON ENCLOSED PARTS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAMPUS 9 THAT ARE: 10 **(1)** OWNED BY THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE; AND 11 **(2)** USED AND EQUIPPED BY THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO PROMOTE 12 OR HOST EVENTS, INCLUDING ARTISTIC, CULTURAL, OR CIVIC EXHIBITS, MEETINGS, FESTIVALS, SHOWS, OR OTHER ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTIONS. 13 14 (C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER AND 15 WINE, AT RETAIL, AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE, FOR ON-PREMISES 16 **CONSUMPTION TO:** 17 INDIVIDUALS WHO ATTEND AN EVENT THAT IS OPEN TO THE **(1)** 18 **PUBLIC**; AND 19 MEMBERS OF A CLUB, A SOCIETY, OR AN ASSOCIATION AND THEIR GUESTS WHO ATTEND AN EVENT THAT IS HELD FOR THAT GROUP. 2021THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT SELL BEER AND WINE ON THE 22 **COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAMPUS AT:** 23 **(1)** A STUDENT SPORTING EVENT; OR 24**(2)** AN EVENT THAT IS SPONSORED BY STUDENTS.

25 (E) AFTER AN EVENT IS OVER, THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW 26 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE CONSUMED ON THE LICENSED PREMISES FROM 27 MIDNIGHT TO NOON THE FOLLOWING DAY.

- 1 (F) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL TO CARRY
  2 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TO OR FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES, EXCEPT A
  3 WHOLESALER OF BEER OR WINE WHO CONDUCTS BUSINESS REGARDING AN EVENT
  4 FOR WHICH A LICENSE HAS BEEN ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 5 (G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2016.
