- 1 (4) At its discretion and in order to conduct any investigation of the petition 2 for waiver, the appropriate board may request that the candidate provide additional 3 information concerning the candidate's financial status.
- 4 (5) If the appropriate board determines that the candidate is unable to pay 5 the required filing fee, the certificate of candidacy shall be issued without payment of the 6 fee.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2016.
