- 1 (3) For a **6-DAY** Class D (off-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license, the 2 annual fee is \$3,000, and the one-time issuance fee for a new license is \$3,000.
- 3 (4) FOR A 7-DAY CLASS D (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE WITHOUT A CATERING PRIVILEGE, THE ANNUAL FEE IS \$1,750, AND THE 5 ONE-TIME ISSUANCE FEE FOR A NEW LICENSE IS \$1,500.
- 6 (5) FOR A 7-DAY CLASS D (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR 7 LICENSE WITH A CATERING PRIVILEGE, THE ANNUAL FEE IS \$2,250, AND THE 8 ISSUANCE FEE FOR A NEW LICENSE IS \$2,000.
